3 Eligibility Criteria

3.1 Eligibility conditions for BBA

Candidates who have passed I0+2 examination from H.P. Board/CBSE/ICSE or any other examination established by law in India considered equivalent to I0+2 by the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla, with at least 45% Marks (40% marks for SC/ST category), shall be eligible.

3.2 Eligibility conditions for BCA

Candidates who have passed I0+2 examination from H.P. Board/CBSE/ ICSE or any other examination established by law in India considered equivalent to 10+2 by the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla, with at least 40% Marks (35% marks for SC/ST category), shall be eligible.

OR

Any examination of a school/Board/college/ University in a foreign country recognized as equivalent for the purpose of eligibility by the Vice-Chancellor /equivalent committee or on the recommendation of Association of the Indian Universities, (AIU) House, 16 Kotla Marg, New Delhi-110002 with at least 40% marks in case of SC/ST candidate.

3.3 Eligibility conditions for PGDCA

Graduate in any discipline with 40% marks. Duration of course should be one year. Direct admission to the 2^{nd} sem, shall not be allowed.

4 Age limit for BBA & BCA

The maximum age limit for fresh admission to BCA/BBA course is 23 years for boys and 25 years for girls, as on Ist July, 2021 However, for candidates of SC/ST categories, there is relaxation of three years. The Vice-Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation for reason (s) to be recorded in writing up to a maximum period of three months.

5 Pass percentage of marks during these courses:

The pass percentage in each paper shall be 40%

2 Reservation of Seats

Admission to each course shall subject to the following conditions:

7.1 15% and 7.5% seats shall be reserved for scheduled caste/scheduled tribe candidates respectively, who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any other institution considered equivalent by the university and located within the territorial jurisdiction of H.P. as per rules.

7.2 The remaining 77.5% seats shall be filled as under:-

- i) 25% of seats for admission shall be open to all the candidates irrespective of the institution from where they have passed their qualifying examination.
- **ii**) 75% of the seats shall be filled out of the ones who have passed their qualifying examination from H.P. Board of School Education or any other school or board (e.g. CBSE or ICSE etc.) located within the territorial jurisdiction of H.P. subject to the following reservation parameters:
 - a) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for outstanding sports persons.
 - **b)** 5% of the seats shall be reserved for candidates with outstanding position in cultural activities.
 - c) 5% of the seats shall be reserved for physically handicapped candidates (only in the absence of a or b above.)

The minimum eligibility condition for admission to the course in case of SC/ST will be 5% lower than the eligibility condition for other students. The roaster for admission showing reservations of the various categories shall be used as per rules of Himachal Pradesh.

Each theory paper shall be of three hour duration and 70 marks. Thirty (30) marks shall be allotted for internal assessment. There will be a Practical Examination of 35 marks, including 15 marks of internal assessment.

Note:- Internal Assessment will be awarded on the basis of mid-term Tests, Surprise Quiz, general behavior (inside & outside the class) overall performance and regularity in the class.

5 Detailed Dress Code

9 Leave Rules

Leave shall be sanctioned on the prescribed application form obtained from the college Library. The application should be duly signed by the parents/guardian. Leave shall be granted only on their recommendation of concerned tutor (s). Leave for more than 5 days shall be granted on the basis of a medical certificate issued by a Physician.

10 End Semester University Examinations, Mid Term Test & Attendance:

It is mandatory to fulfill the condition of Lecture attendance & mid-term test as laid down by the University. In case, a student fails to fulfill any of these conditions; he/she shall not be allowed to sit in the end semester examination.

- **1.)** Each student shall have to attend at least 75% of the total lectures delivered in theory & practical separately in each concerned subject (module).
- **2.**) Each Student must secure at least 20% marks in each subject or 30% marks in an aggregate all compulsory and elective subjects during the mid-term tests to be eligible in end semester examination.

The names (s) of the student (s) who remain absent for 10 days or more continuously from any class without prior sanction of Leave, shall be struck off the college rolls.

However the Principal may re-admit such students (s) on the recommendation of teacher (s) concerned and on the payment of prescribed re-admission fee within 10 days after the strucking of his/her name.

11 Readmission Fee

Important: No Student shall be Re-admitted for the third time during a given semester.

12 Library Rules

- a) There is a provision of library cards for the students to avail of library facilities.

These units are whole heartedly engaged in regular and special camp activities in and around the college as envisaged under the spirit of this scheme.
