Note:- Final Admission Committee is fully responsible and authorized to scrutinize and approve all admissions of all classes (UG/PG) for the current academic session on behalf of the Principal. The committee is expected to follow all rules and regulations as prescribed by the Himachal Pradesh University Shimla and the Department of Higher Education.



GENERAL ADMISSION RULES FOR UG COURSES

Admission shall be made on the recommendation of admission committee.

1. Admission shall be done strictly on fulfillment of eligibility conditions.
2. A student who has attained the age of 23 year for boys & 25 years for girls on 1st July, 2025 (upper age limit is raised to 26 years for ST/SC Candidates) are eligible for admission. The Vice-Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum period of 6 months.
3. All admissions will be provisional subject to the final approval of HPU Shimla.
4. All terms and conditions of the admission and fee structure can be changed or modified as per the directions of higher competent authorities.
5. A student must produce original certificate at the time of admission.
6. A candidate having a gap of one or more year in his/her studies will have to submit an undertaking/affidavit explaining the reason.

Important Note:-

All such students who are required to produce undertaking/affidavit are advised to consult the admission committee about the contents/statement to be given so that inconvenience

may be avoided. Submission of false undertaking is a legal offence.

7. Every student seeking admission in any class will be required to pay Rs750/- towards PTA fund.
8. Girl students seeking admission in any class must bring an attested copy of H.P. Bonafide certificate to avail fee concession in tuition fee.
9. Students seeking exemption from tuition fee for disability must attach an attested copy of 40% disability
10. The admission of a student who is seeking admission to any UG Class on the basis of educational qualification acquired from the University other than HPU Shimla shall be regularized on the basis of equivalence of syllabi as and when decided by HP University, Shimla.
11. Candidate coming from school of education Board/University other than HP Board of School Education/HPU Shimla must produce original copy of migration certificates. Only those students who have passed in all subjects in 10+2 from NOS (with English) shall be admitted to BA/B.Sc./B.Com. subject to the minimum eligibility conditions.

Note:-

1. Admissions in various major subjects will be on the basis of merit & other eligibility conditions keeping in view the HPU Shimla roster for reservations.
2. Admission in Sports & Culture Quota will be done/approved by the faculty of Physical Education & Music respectively.

BACHELOR OF ARTS (B.A)

Eligibility for Admission:-

B.A. Pass Courses:- Passed +2 examination under 10+2 or an examination equivalent thereto of a Board/University established by law in India provided that a student seeking admission to B.A. 1st Year with Mathematics one of the subjects of study, should have either 45% marks in aggregate or 45% marks in Mathematics at +2 level.

Or

Intermediate examination of an Indian University/ Board or an examination recognized equivalent there to.

Or

Any examination of a University/Board/ College or School in Foreign Country recognized as equivalence for the above purpose by the Vice Chancellor/ Equivalence Committee either of its own or on the recommendations of the Association Indian Universities.

BACHELOR OF COMMERCE (B.Com.)

B.Com. Pass Course: Passed +2 examination under 10+2 or an examination equivalent thereto of a Board/University established by law in Indian with pass in all written subjects (including English) with 40% marks

Or

Pre-University examination (two years) after 10 years Schooling of an Indian University/Board recognized by H.P University with 45% marks or 40% for those who have passed 10+2 examination under Commerce stream.

Or

Any examination of a University/Board/College or School in a Foreign Country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/Equivalence Committee either of its own or on the recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with 45% marks or 40% for those who have passed +2 examinations under 10+2 of any recognized Board.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B.Sc.)

Bachelor of Science (Pass Course): Passed +2 examination under 10+2 examination or an examination equivalent thereof of a Board/University established by law in India with pass in written subjects, with 45% marks.

Or

Pre-University Science Examination (two years) after 10 years schooling of an Indian University/Board recognized in four written papers. (one English and three Science subjects with 45% marks)

Or

Intermediate Science Examination of an Indian University/Board or an examination recognized equivalent thereto with pass in four written subjects (one English and three science elective subjects with 45% marks)

Or

Any examination of a University/Board/College or School in a Foreign Country recognized as equivalent for the above purpose by the Vice-Chancellor/Equivalence Committee either of its own or on the recommendations of Association of Indian Universities with 45% marks.

REFUSAL OF ADMISSION

- ✚ A candidate expelled by any college/University or found involved in any disciplinary activities in the preceding year(s) will not be admitted in the college.
- ✚ Any candidate who has not appeared/passed in English as a subject at 10+2 level shall not be eligible for admission in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. 1st year.
- ✚ If the student gets admission by furnishing incorrect information or by concealing the facts His/her admission will be cancelled on detection of such fault by the college/University.
- ✚ In spite of the eligibility for admission, the Principal can refuse admission if the conduct of the student has not been up to the mark during previous years
- ✚ The Principal reserves the right to reject or cancel the admission of any student without assigning any reason or explanation if situation warrants so.



GUIDELINES AND ADMISSION RULES FOR MASTER'S DEGREE (M.A./M.COM.)

The college offers postgraduate courses in the subjects of English, Hindi & Commerce: with 30 seats in each subject.

GENERAL RULES

1. The admission to these courses will be made based on marks/merit obtained in HPU entrance test to be conducted by Himachal Pradesh University Shimla.
2. The minimum qualifying marks in entrance test will be 35% to make the candidates eligible for interview/admission. In case of SC/ST candidates, the minimum qualifying marks shall be reduced until the full SC/ST quota for admission has been exhausted.
3. An applicant who is placed under compartment in B.A./B.Com./B.Sc.III examination is not eligible for admission to the master's degree in the subject in which he/she has been placed in compartment.
4. Age limit: A student who has attained the age of 26 years for boys & 28 years for girls on 1st July 2023. The upper age limit is raised to 29 years for ST/SC candidates. The Vice- Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation up to a maximum period of 6 months for reasons to be recorded in writing. However, the age bar shall not apply in the case of candidates in service nominated by the Government of H.P.
5. A candidate who fails in I semester may be permitted to join II semester, but he/she shall not be permitted to proceed from I semester to III semester without appearing in the examination.
6. At the time of I semester examination, the candidate may appear along with the II semester papers (if the University rules otherwise permit), but the student shall not be permitted to proceed from III semester to the IV semester without appearing in the examination.
7. The admission of a student migrating from another university shall be treated as provisional and shall be confirmed only when he/she produces the migration certificate and character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
8. The admission will be made purely on merit except where otherwise mentioned,

subject to the number of seats available and the reservation as per university rules/roster. (Vide HPU Letter No. 158/2006 HPU (DS) for admission in PG Classes). HPU, Shimla will conduct centralized entrance test. After declaration of the result student will have to apply online on the college website.

9. The minimum eligibility for admission to Post Graduate courses will be 20-24 credits in subject concerned in the undergraduate degree.
10. The forms will be filled up online. The fee deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.

ADMISSION TO M.A. ENGLISH

Basis of Admission and Eligibility

The admission will be made strictly based on marks obtained in Entrance Test conducted by HPU Shimla. The test will be open to all with any graduate degree such as BA/B.Sc/ B.Com./B.Sc. (Agri.), B.Sc. (Home Science), B.Sc.(Engg.), MBBS/ BAMS/ GAMS/ B.Pharm or B.Ed.or B. Lib./B.V.Sc./ B.E./ B.Tech./ Vashistha, Shastri/ BBA/ BCA of a University Established by law in India with a minimum of 48credits in Major subject, 48 credits in two minor subjects, 9 credits in compulsory, 1 credit in GI & hobby with aggregate of 106 credits/132 credits under new system.

Or

A Bachelor's degree with at least second division (50% marks) in aggregate or 45% marks or Honours in the subject in which admission to MA is sought. For SC/ST candidates the eligibility will be 45% in aggregate or 40% marks in the subject of Honors in the subject of study of M.A.

Master of Arts (MA Hindi):-

The admission will be based on HP Entrance Test merit list. A Bachelor's degree or equivalent with a minimum of 48 credits in Major subject, 48 credits in two minor subjects, 9 credits in compulsory, 1 credit in GI &Hobby with aggregate of 106 credits/132 credits under new system or with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% in case of SC.ST) from a university established by law in India. The minimum eligibility for admission to Post Graduate courses will be 20-24 credits in subject concerned in the undergraduate degree.

Master of Commerce (M. Com.)

B.Com./B.Com. (Hons) /BBA with 50% marks or BA/B.Sc. Degree with Mathematics /Statistics /Economics with 50% marks in Economics /Statistics /Mathematics and 50% marks in aggregate are eligible for admission to M.Com. The admission in M.Com. will be based on HP Entrance Test merit list. The minimum marks in HPU entrance test should be 35. If any seat remains vacant, then it will be filled up based onB.Com./B.A./BSc. CGPA merit list.

Basis of Admission:-

The admission to these courses will be made strictly on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance Test and shall be open to all, subject to the reservation approved by the University. The merit will be determined on the basis of competitive examination. The minimum qualifying marks for the Entrance Test will be 35% (in case of SC/ST candidates, the

minimum qualifying marks shall be reduced until the full SC/ST quota for admission has been exhausted) for calling the candidates for Interview/Admission.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE



1. All candidates are advised to fill their online admission form on their own mobile phone/laptop, or in the “**Lokmitra Kendra / Cyber Cafe**” nearby their hometown.
2. All the candidates are directed to register with their **personal mobile number, and email address**, as all the future communication will be done by the admission committees using these mobile number and email address only.
3. Candidate must save the “**Username and Password**” generated during registration process with them, and complete the admission process by filling the online application form using their **own username and password** from “**Login to Apply**” button.
4. Candidate needs to fill the online admission form using his/her own credentials, after that only his/her candidature will be considered for admission. **Registration alone does not make any candidate eligible for admission.**
5. During online filling of application form you need to enter all information correctly, and only upload the “**scanned copy of original documents**” and pay an amount of registration fee if applicable. Only after paying Registration fee the candidate will finally be able to submit the application forms if registration fee is required there. You must have to submit your Form to complete registration process.
6. **Photostat copies of documents are not accepted.** If admission committee found any uploaded Photostat copy at the time of form verification then their admission form will be rejected, and candidates need to rectify the rejected form from his/her account, and **resubmit** it again.
7. At the time of form verification admission committee holds all the rights to reject any uploaded documents, if documents are not uploaded in the prescribed format mentioned in the instructions provided at the time of documents upload. Then student will be communicated by the committee through “**SMS and Email**” in their registered mobile number and email address to do the needful changes.
8. Candidate then needs to make the corrections by Logging in their account using their username and password and resubmit the form again and wait for final approval which will be intimated through **SMS and Email within a week.**
9. After final approval from admission committee candidate will be informed by his/her respective committee **to pay the fee through SMS and Email** in their register mobile number and email address.
10. Candidate need to pay the fee online to complete the admission process by logging in their account using his/her own username and password.

11. In case of any query related to online admission, candidate can contact concerned admission committee.

STEPS FOR REGISTRATIONS

Applicant(s) are required to apply online through college official website ie <https://www.gcbangana.ac.in/> or <https://admission.gcbangana.ac.in/> No other means/modes of application are acceptable.

Click on the tab “**New Registration**”. You will be directed to the registration form page.

A valid own Mobile number, please keep it active, at least until the admission process is complete as all communication will be sent through SMS. An e-Mail ID belonging to the candidate is required.

UID Aadhar number or Enrollment number, note down your username and password and click on “**Login to Apply**”.

STEPS FOR FILLING ONLINE APPLICATION FORM

- Now enter your “Username” and “Password” to fill the application form.
- Fields marked as red star mandatory to fill.
- Enter all your “personal details, permanent address, and educational qualifications” asked in this form. Check the subsequent sub category in which you fall. And Click on “**Save and Next**” button.
- In Education section you must have to add your marks details by clicking on **Add %** Button. A popup window will appear to fill marks details. Enter your marks details in textbox. If you passed under CGPA select Yes option and add your grade point, for your help CGPA grade table is there. After filling details select click Calculate Button then Press **save** button.
- In Sub-categories and Activities section select appropriate applicable option.
 - a) Press save to application and move to next page to upload the scanned copy of original documents in the desired columns as per the format given below:
 - b) Only file types - jpg, jpeg, png and pdf of size 500KB are supported.
 - c) Upload recent and clear photographs/documents.
 - d) Your photo should be of passport size in jpeg/png format with minimum dimensions as 200x200 pixels and your face should be clearly visible.
 - e) In case you don't have certificate for a selected category just go back, unselect that category and save the form.
 - f) After uploading, you may also upload again if required.
 - g) Documents uploaded will be examined by Admission Committee. You may receive remarks for any modification/update.
 - h) Click on “**Next**” button.
- Here check all the documents if they were uploaded correctly or not. You can also upload any document again if it was not uploaded correctly. After checking click on “**Next**” button.

- Here in this page check all the details filled by you in the form; you can edit any column here if data is not filled correctly. After checking check all the boxes in the check list, and click on **“Continue”** button and pay the registration Fee if applicable otherwise you can directly submit the form. Once your payment confirmation comes your form will be automatically get submitted.
- Here in this page check all the details filled by you in the form; you can edit any column here if data is not filled correctly. After checking check all the boxes in the check list, and click on **“Continue”** button and pay the registration Fee if applicable otherwise you can directly submit the form. Once your payment confirmation comes your form will be automatically get submitted.

- Now the admission committee will verify the application form. In case of any discrepancy found in the online admission form, it will be communicated to the student by **SMS** or **Email** in the registered mobile number and email address provided by candidate at the time of registration.
- If candidate will receive any message regarding form rectification then he/she need to rectify the form from his/her account using their **“username and password”**. Hence, they are again requested to retain their account information with them until the completion of admission process.
- After receiving any updates from the admission committee regarding approval of application form candidate needs to pay the admission fee online from their user account.
- It is directed to students to retain the hard/soft copy of filled application form and fee receipt with them. In case, if any discrepancy found during student admission they need to submit it at college. If any student fails to submit these documents when called his/her admission is subjected to cancellation.
- It is advised to regularly check email, SMS and visit College site for latest updates over admission process.

ANNUAL SYSTEM:-

An academic year comprises of 180 working days with six working days in a week which would mean that in a year will be having $180/6=30$ teaching/working weeks. Considering that each teaching day has 5 teaching or working hour, week would have $5*6=30$ working/teaching hours and in an academic session $30*30=900$ hours available for each student.

CREDITS:-

The term 'credit' refers to the weight age given to a course, usually in terms of the number of instructional hours per week assigned to it. This explains why usually 'credit' is taken to mean 'credit hours'. For the award of degree in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. the student has to accumulate a minimum of 132 credits successfully. The UG programme for a regular student shall be for a minimum period of three years and a maximum of five years from the date of Admission of the candidate.

Number of seats in all the major subjects for admission to 1st year of B.A./B.Sc. B.Com. under CBCS are fixed. Hence the admission in the major subject is purely on merit basis.

COURSES OFFERED:-

The UG Programme comprises of the following courses:

CORE COURSES:-

Four discipline specific papers each for English and Hindi/MIL in B.A./B.Com.: The purpose of fixing core papers is to ensure that all the institutions follow a minimum common designed curriculum so that each institution/university adheres to common minimum standard. Also the courses assigned for papers under this category aim to cover the basics that a student is expected to imbibe in that particular discipline. A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a core course.

ELECTIVE COURSES:-

Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables and provides exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidates proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.

DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC ELECTIVE (DSE) COURSE:-

Elective course offered under the main discipline/subject of study are suggestive in nature and each University has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need. The University/Institute may also offer discipline related Elective Courses of interdisciplinary nature (to be offered by main discipline/subject to study.)

GENERIC ELECTIVE (GE) COURSE:-

An Elective course chosen from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline of choice is called Generic Elective. The purpose of this category of papers is to offer the students the option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices they make in Core and Discipline Specific Elective papers. The list provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each university has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirements, scope and need. A core course so offered in discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic .

ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COMPULSORY COURSES (AECC):-

The Ability Enhancement Compulsory (AECC) Courses are of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). "AECC" courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to knowledge enhancement: Environmental Science (ii) English/Hindi/MIL Communication. These are mandatory for all disciplines. 'SEC courses' are value based and/or skills based and are aimed at providing hands on training, competencies, skills etc. The main purpose of these courses is to provide students life-skills in hand-on mode so as to increase their employability. The list provided under this category are suggestive in nature and each University has complete freedom to suggest their own papers under this category based on their expertise, specialization, requirement, scope and need.

PRACTICAL/TUTORIALS:-

One each with every core and discipline/generic specific elective paper

The list of practicals provided is suggestive in nature and each university has the freedom to add/subtract/edit practical from the list depending on their faculty and infrastructure available. Addition will however be of similar nature.

Students are advised to bring exact amount of fee/dues tothe fee counter. In case of balance payment (if any) student shall ensure its receipt before actually leaving the fee counter.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION SYSTEM :-

The Evaluation System in CBCS consists of the following components:

CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT (CCA)

Accounting for 30% of the final grade that a student gets in a course.

FINAL EXAMINATION

Accounting for the remaining 70% of the final grade that a student gets in a course.

CONTINUOUS COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT (CCA)

Accounting of this would have the following components:

CLASSROOM ATTENDANCE

- ✚ Each student will have to attend a minimum of 75% Lectures/Tutorial+Practical. A student having less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the final examination.
- ✚ Provided that those having between 74% and 65% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by clear reason(s) for absence to the authorized functionaries.
- ✚ Provided that those having between 64% and 50% attendance will apply for exemption in a prescribed form accompanied by a Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital.
- ✚ Provided exemption from 75% attendance will be given to those participating in prescribed co-curricular activities (e.g. NCC, NSS, Youth Festivals, Sports etc.) to the extent of 25% (making the necessary attendance as 50% in these cases). However, the claim for this exemption should be supported by authenticated certificate from the concerned college authorities.

Those having greater than 75% attendance will be awarded CCA marks as follows:-

>75% but <79% 1 Mark	80% but <84% 2 Marks
>84% but <89% 3 Marks	90% but <94% 4 Marks
95% 5 Marks		

HOUSE EXAMINATION:-

House examination will be conducted after 90 days of teaching and shall be of 15 marks. It is mandatory to appear in house examination & must score 45% marks to become eligible for final examination.

SEMINAR/ ASSIGNMENTS:-

- (I) 10 marks of the CCA will be awarded on the basis of seminar/assignments etc. that the course teacher might give to the students.
- (i) The remaining 5 marks of the CCA will be awarded on the basis of attendance as per criteria mentioned above.
- (ii) Final Examination: The remaining 70% of the final grade of the student in a course will be on the basis of Final examination that will be of three hours duration and covering the whole syllabus of the course.

RIGHT TO APPEAL:

The photocopies of the evaluated answer books will be made available to the students on demand for a fee (to be decided depending on the cost of reproduction per answer book) to be paid in advance. The student will have the right to make an appeal against any component of evaluation. Such appeal has to be made to the Principal of the College on a prescribed form

and should clearly state in writing the reason for the complaint/appeal.

The appeal will be placed before the Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC), Chaired by the College Principal, comprising:

For cases pertaining to the Major subject (core or elective courses) : the Head of the Department, course teacher and a senior teacher of the department For cases pertaining to the Electives of the Minor subjects: the Head of the Department (of the Major) Course teacher and a senior teacher of the department of the Minor subject. The committee will consider the case and may give a personal hearing to the appellant before deciding the case. The decision of the Committee will be final. The marks obtained in the CCA and the final examination will be combined and used in deciding the course grade that the student will be getting. Absolute grading will be done by the officer of the COE, HPU for each course.

CONFERMENT TO THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE:

The result would be declared by the COE of the Himachal Pradesh University and the degree would also be conferred by the respective university. A candidate shall be eligible for the conferment of the Bachelor's degree only if he/she has earned the minimum required credits for the programme prescribed i.e. 132 credits. The top three scores of University Exam in each UG course will respectively be awarded Gold, Silver and Bronze medals by the HPU.

REVISION OF REGULATION AND CURRICULUM:

Whenever necessary, the HPU may revise, amend and change the regulations and curriculum from time to time, after the due approval of the different bodies and authorities of the University.

COLLEGE FEE AND DUES AS APPROVED BY THE GOVERNMENT:-

1. Every student must pay dues on the dates notified from time to time.
2. Failure to pay dues on the notified date will entail a fine of Rs. 1/- per day.
3. Library security will be refunded within one year of leaving the college otherwise it will lapse automatically.
4. If student does not deposit college fee & dues as second installment in time, his/her name will automatically be struck off from the college rolls.
5. Special fine if any can be imposed by the college.
6. On migration from other institution, funds for the entire session including library security and other funds from the time of joining the colleges shall be charged.
7. Registration fee will not be charged from a student migrating from another college if he/she is already registered with Himachal Pradesh University.

GENERAL CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE RULES:-

All the students must note that Ragging inside/outside the college campus is a cognizable offence. Any of the following activities will be considered a breach of discipline:

- Ragging in any form.
- Graffiti i.e. any sort of writing on the wall/blackboards/room etc.
- Damaging the college property in any manner.
- Loitering in corridors and causing disturbance in the classes.
- Possession or use of drugs and indulgence in smoking in the campus.
- Bringing outsider to the college.
- Sticking any kind of bill/notice on the notice board without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Creating any kind of violence or nuisance in the campus.
- Coming without Identity Card in the college.

- Use of mobile phones by the students is strictly prohibited except the allotted area. The violator should be fined accordingly.

IMPORTANT NOTE:-

- ✚ Stringent action will be taken against student found guilty of breaching conduct or discipline rules in the college campus, by the college administration.
- ✚ Defaulters including students whose name has been struck off the roll(s) are not allowed to enter the college premises until exonerated or re-admitted appropriately.

ATTENDANCE:-

- At least 75% lecture attendance is compulsory for appearing in the university exam.
- An irregular student or one who remains absent continuously for 7 days from College his/her name will be struck off from the college rolls. If name of a student is struck-off twice, he/she will not be re-admitted to the college.
A student is liable to pay all dues & fines as long as his/her name remains on the college rolls.
- The Principal reserves the right of expulsion/suspension of any student if the situation warrants so.

LEAVE RULES:-

- ✚ Application for any kind of leave on the prescribed Proforma should be submitted well in time.
- ✚ Leave up to three days will be sanctioned by the concerned subject teacher.
- ✚ The Head of Department is competent to sanction leave up to 6 Days.
- ✚ Leave for more than six days shall be sanctioned by the Principal.
- ✚ In case of medical leave for a period of 6 days or more, the applicant must produce a medical certificate.

IMPORTANT NOTE:-

Students participating in inter college competitions should note that the practice/rehearsal timing should be either before the classes (early morning) or after the classes (evening) because all such activities do not substitute academics.

LIBRARY RULES:-

Every student will be issued an Identity Card. Since "I-Card" is the only medium to identify/differentiate a bonafide college student from an outsider, every student must always carry it with him/her and must produce it, whenever required (during all working days, examination (s) and college function (s) etc. otherwise he/she will be considered an outsider and will be punished accordingly.

If the I-card is lost, a duplicate card will be issued only after an FIR is registered with nearest police station an original copy thereof is appended with such a request Rs. 20/- are to be deposited for a duplicate Identity Card.

SCHOLARSHIP/AWARDS:-

The college offers various scholarships and awards to poor and meritorious students, regulated by the rules available in the college.

- Indira Gandhi Utkrishta Chattravritti Yojna-IRDP Scholarship.
- Dr. Ambedkar Post Metric Scholarship scheme for economically backward classes.
- Post Metric Scholarship scheme to SC, ST and OBC students.
- Kalpana Chawla Scholarship.

These scholarships are awarded to students as per norms and rules prescribed by the department. The students should apply for these scholarships through HP e-pass website recommended by the scholarship committee.

OLD STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION (OSA):-

One of the main purposes of this association is to provide platform to bring together the former graduates of this institution to share and utilize their rich experience for the benefit and progress of present students in their endeavour for better employment and higher studies. The registration of this society is in progress and efforts are being made to expedite the process.

EDUCATIONAL TOURS:-

Educational tours are arranged only during winter vacation:

- Routes will be recommended by the concerned committee and approved by the principal.
- Students will have to produce written permission from their parents for joining such tours.
- The college will provide limited financial support as permitted under rules.

COLLEGE STUDENTS' CENTRAL ASSOCIATION (CSCA):-

The college gives due representation to students as a link between students, teachers and administration. The students' body called CSCA is elected as per the norms and direction of HPU. It follows the recommendations of Lyngdoh Committee. The contribution of CSCA is instrumental in the smooth functioning of college activities.

YOUTH FESTIVAL:-

It is organized by HP University in four groups - I, II, III & IV. The students having highly commended position in youth festival are given reservation in HP University PG Courses.

VARIOUS UNITS OF COLLEGE

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC):-

This institution has the honour of running NCC with Army wing.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS):-

It is volunteer association of young students participating in various activities that aims at developing their personality through community service. Presently the college has one NSS Unit. In each unit 33% seats are reserved for girls. The students who attend 240 hours of social service and attend 7 days special camp are given a special benefit of 2% marks at the time of admission to the H.P. University P.G. Courses.

ROVERS & RANGERS (R&R):-

It is a worldwide association of well disciplined volunteers. It has two wings, one for girls (rangers) and one for boys (rovers). The students who obtain a (NIPUN) certificate are eligible for 2% marks weightage while seeking employment in railways and other government institutions.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE:-

To nourish the creativity among the students, the college magazine "GOVINDIKA" is published every year. It has many sections like Hindi, Sanskrit, Pahari, English and Science etc. One student editor for each section is also appointed at the beginning of academic session.

FEEDBACK/APPRECIATION:

A Suggestion Box is installed in the college campus to invite the general advice, suggestion or information from the students about how good or useful the institutional work is and what measures can be adopted to make its functioning more meaningful, purposeful and result oriented.

TEACHERS' APPRAISAL :-

The teachers are evaluated by the students twice during the academic session through a "Prescribed Feedback Performa".

CAREER GUIDANCE-CUM-COUNSELING AND PLACEMENT CELL:-

The UGC formulated "Career Guidance-cum-Counseling and Placement Cell" has been constituted in the college with an aim to prepare the students for job or self reliance. This cell is fully devoted to help the students in proper choice of courses and ultimate choice of their career as per their potential and capabilities. The cell ensures to provide proper counseling as and when needed by any students.

ANTI RAGGING/DISCIPLINE RULES:-

In order to have zero tolerance to ragging and its total elimination from the educational institutions. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its orders date 4th May, 2007 and 11th Feb., 2009 has directed as here under:

Ragging is strictly prohibited in the institution. Anyone indulging in ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. Punishment shall be exemplary and justifiably harsh. Punishment for ragging includes:

- ✚ Imprisonment
- ✚ Expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes for a limited period and fine with a public apology.
- ✚ Withholding scholarships or other benefits.
- ✚ Debarring from representation in events.
- ✚ Withholding of result.
- ✚ If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not identified collective punishment shall be resorted to.
- ✚ Character/migration certificate(s) issued by the institution shall have an entry apart from that of general conduct and behavior to the effect whether the student had participated in particular was punished for ragging.
- ✚ In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging/indiscipline in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission shall be refused to him/her or he/she shall be expelled from the institution forth with.
