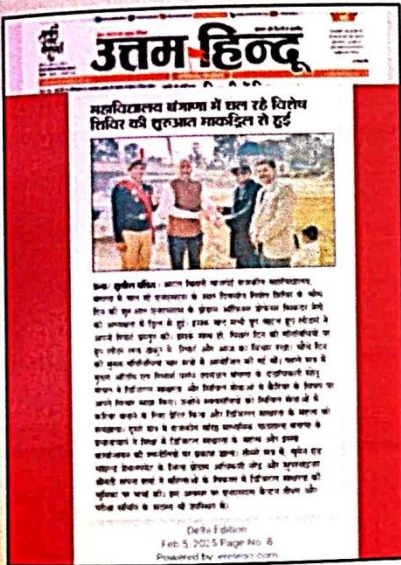

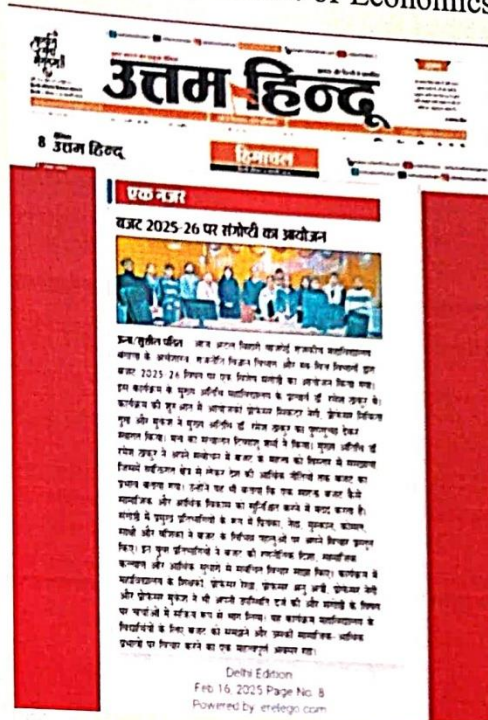


15 FEBRUARY 2025
