1. Academic Development Plan

Road Map: For Academic Development various members of MoU's have been signed with the University for faculty & students' to ensure interactions with the outer word. Efforts will be made to tie up the College Industry partnership for the economic development of the students.

2. Infrastructure Development

Objective: Upgrade college facilities to meet modern educational needs.

- **Campus Expansion:** If necessary, acquire additional land or buildings for academic and extracurricular activities.
- **Laboratory and Library Upgradation:** Procure new equipment and resources to facilitate better learning outcomes. This will help to improve library resources, focus on digital access to journals and research materials.
- **ICT and Smart Classrooms:** Expand digital infrastructure, introduce e-learning platforms, and upgrade the IT network for better connectivity and online education.

Implement renewable energy sources, install garbage treatment plants, and create green spaces

Road Map: As HPPWD Authorities have denied for handicapped ramp from ground floor to first floor Digital Library will site (Previously they consented to establish, but their chief rejected it) hence, be established with this money amounting Rs. 1071026 (Provided by DHE). Rain harvesting Tank will be made operational with the consultation of Higher authorities. Diesel generator will be shifted near the canteen to make it more beneficial for the institution. Various labs, viz., Botany Zoology Chemistry/Computer will be equipped with new apparatus as per the demands of concerned incharges. Mathematics/Commerce labs are in the pipeline of the medium term plan of college. We also plan to develop botanical garden in the college. Moreover, estimate of water tank and white wash has also been sent to higher authorities to be financed out of common pool.

3. Faculty and Staff Development

Objective: Ensure teaching quality by investing in faculty training.

- **Professional Development:** Organizing workshops, seminars, and conferences to upgrade faculty skills and knowledge.
- Encouraging faculty to participate in national and international conferences.
- Implementing faculty exchange programs with reputed institutions.

Research Grants: Provide financial support for research and academic publications as per the norms.

4. Student Development and Support

Objective: To foster student growth beyond academics.

- **Career Counseling and Placement Cell:** Establishing a strong placement cell for job placement support, internships, and skill-building workshops.
- **Counseling and Mental Health Support:** Provide mental health support through regular counseling sessions, mentoring, stress-relieving sessions, workshops on stress management, and awareness campaigns on mental well-being.
- **Offering yoga, fitness** awareness classes, and volunteering opportunities in health screening camps.
- **Remedial Classes:** Creating remedial classes tailored to students with slower learning paces to address their unique needs and enhance their confidence and performance.
- **Skill Development Programs:** Introducing short-term certificate courses or skill-based training programs.
- **Student Scholarships:** To strengthen scholarship programs for economically weaker students.
- **Support student clubs,** societies, and sports teams, promoting leadership and team-building skills.

Road Map: Efforts will be made to conduct job fair in the College through career Guidance Cell in new future. Various skill based courses such as AI/ Beautification, Computer Basic and Yoga will be started with the consultation of various stake holders.

5. Community Engagement and Partnership:

Objective: Build a strong connection with the community and local industries.

- Collaborate with local industries for internships, sponsorships, and practical projects.
- Host open events, inviting local stakeholders to engage with the college.
